While our customer, employee, and community needs vary in each of these geographies, one thing is the same: our commitment to "Looking after the Environment for Future Generations". Harmac will continue to utilize the framework created by the United Nations to work towards <u>Good Health and Well-Being</u>, <u>Sustainable Cities and Communities</u>, and <u>Responsible Consumption and Production</u> at each of our locations.

Good Health and Well-Being

Encourage healthy habits with an annual walking challenge, onsite blood pressure monitoring equipment, and onsite education programs for healthy living.

Sustainable Cities and Communities

Support local charities and community events. Train employee volunteers in CPR and First Aid to assist in emergencies and support local first responders.

Responsible Consumption and Production

Continue tracking scope 1 & 2 emissions data to understand our carbon footprint and create baseline data for future projects. Conduct sustainability assessments of key suppliers to determine their environmental and social commitments.





2024 Sustainability Achievements

Good Health and Well-Being

- Employees from each facility competed in the 4th Annual Walking Challenge. 83 people walked over 29 million steps in one month!
- Offered employees a variety of onsite programs and information on mental health, cancer awareness, and overall well-being. This included health screenings and free vaccine clinics on-site.

Sustainable Cities and Communities

- Supported charities local to each facility. This included the Hospice, FeedMore WNY, Camp Good Days, and Roscommon SPCA.
- Annual College scholarship program for the children and grandchildren of Harmac employees. In the past 11 years, 41 scholarships have been awarded.

Responsible Consumption and Production

- Continue converting to energy-efficient LED lighting. Buffalo has completed 100% of production areas, and Castlerea has completed 100% of the facility.
- Buffalo and Castlerea completed Facility Energy Audits.
- Replaced disposable coffee and water cups with reusable alternatives.



Previous Sustainability Achievements

- 2023: Castlerea completed 5 energy savings projects for a total CO2 savings of 112 tons per year.
- 2023: Buffalo converted an additional 4,000 sq ft to LED lighting.
- 2023: Achieved Zero Waste to Landfill at Castlerea facility.
- 2022: Provided on-site First Aid Training to employee volunteers in Buffalo & Castlerea.
- 2022: Added Blood Pressure Kiosk for self-monitoring in Buffalo.
- 2022: Supported charities local to each facility, including Hospice, FeedMore WNY, Camp Good Days, BUMBLEance, and STEAM education.
- 2022: Partnered with local non-profits for workforce development and apprentice programs in Buffalo.
- 2022: Replaced facility compressor with energy-efficient upgrade in Buffalo.
- 2022: Achieved Zero Waste to Landfill at Castlerea facility.
- 2021: Employees from each facility competed in a month-long walking challenge. Castlerea earned the trophy.
- 2021: Offered on-site vaccine clinics for employees and family members at all 3 sites.
- 2021: Replaced two injection mold machines with new equipment to improve efficiency. Old equipment was repurposed and kept out of landfills. (Buffalo)
- 2021: Updated Air Handler Unit to improve efficiency, reducing energy for air handling by 17% (Castlerea)
- 2021: Installed water-saving equipment in all facility restrooms (Tijuana)
- 2020: Added thermal camera screening at all facility entrances, plexiglass shields, updated workstation layouts, changed work schedules for social distancing at all 3 sites
- 2020: Added staff for increased cleaning and disinfecting and self-sanitizing stations at all 3 sites
- 2020: Provided food, masks, gloves, and financial donations to people and organizations in need during COVID-19 in Buffalo, Tijuana, and Castlerea
- 2019: All manufacturing clean rooms converted to LED lighting in Buffalo, NY
- 2018: Implemented composting program in Buffalo, NY
- 2018: Reduced "Sharps" production waste by 5% in Buffalo, NY
- 2018: Reduced energy consumption by an additional 5% in Castlerea, Ireland
- 2017: Converted 1 of 3 clean rooms to LED lighting in Buffalo, NY
- 2017: Reduced cost of electricity per unit of sales by 33.6% in Castlerea, Ireland
- 2016: Increased plastic recycling to 46% in Buffalo, NY
- 2016: Reduced energy consumption by 5% in Castlerea, Ireland
- 2015: 15% reduction in the cost of electricity per unit of sales in Castlerea, Ireland
- 2014: ISO 14001 certification at Harmac HQ in Buffalo, NY
- 2013: Replaced street lights adjacent to the facility with LED versions in coordination with the Town of Castlerea to decrease power usage.
- 2012: Harmac HQ in Buffalo, NY, began using hydroelectric power for 10% of its needs.
- 2012: We donated a new fitness center to the Town of Castlerea for the use of our employees and residents.
- 2011: 14001 certified in our Castlerea, Ireland facility.
